- General Application Guidelines

All applications and essays must be typed. Handwritten submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances. Applicants are required to complete the entire application form. Any application that contains incorrect or incomplete information will not be considered for review.

- Formatting and Submission Rules

All necessary information must be provided within the space allotted on the application form. Additional lines or separate pages are not permitted and will not be accepted as part of your submission. Except for the essay section, every portion of the application must be filled out using the designated form provided.

- Required Documentation

A copy of the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) page showing the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) for college expenses must accompany your scholarship application. References and transcripts should not be included with your application materials.

- Notification of Recipients

Applicants selected to receive the scholarship will be notified by both telephone and letter before the end of June 2026.

- Important Anonymity Instructions

To ensure an unbiased review process, do not include your name, school or district name, club names, or sports affiliations on page three, page four, or in any essay submitted with the application. Applications are reviewed without identifying information to prevent favoritism.
